
Summer camps provide a caring, safe space that contributes to camper and staff well-being.



At camp, staff must:

- Supervise, manage, and support a group of children for an entire day and weeks at a time
- Be held accountable for their words and actions
- Receive feedback and constructive criticism
- Manage their time throughout the day
- Lead group activities
- Communicate with peers and supervisors
- Keep children safe
- Navigate emotional and behavior issues
- Organize schedules and details
- Resolve conflict
- Adapt and be flexible when plans change
