

**Parents' Association of The Bronx High School of Science**  
**General Meeting Minutes**  
**June 2, 2016**

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by Ellen Dubin, co-President, at 7:05 pm. Approximately 35 parents were in attendance.

**Approve May Minutes:** There was a motion from the floor to approve the May 2016 Meeting minutes; the motion was seconded and the minutes were approved by show of hands, with none opposed

**Principal's Report:** There was no principal's report as Dr. Donahue was meeting with the Alumni Association and unable to attend

**Auction & Bronx Week Parade Update:**

- The annual auction was held on the evening of Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. A total of 215 parents / guests attended the fun-filled evening. Expenses are still being reconciled, however the event will most certainly exceed the budgeted fundraising goal of \$50,000.
  
- On Sunday, May 15<sup>th</sup>, members of the Bronx Science community participated in the Bronx Week Parade for the second year. Borough President Ruben Diaz sponsored this weeklong celebration of the Bronx culminating in a Sunday parade along Mosholu Parkway. Approximately 60 Bronx Science parents and students, including members of the Robotics team and a robot, marched in the parade. The robot threw t-shirts to B.P. Diaz in the grandstand, which was a big hit. The event was good for the community and demonstrated the school's commitment to the borough.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Heidi Moustakos reported on the current balances, fundraising progress to date, budgeted income, and expenses.

Elizabeth Newberry reviewed the proposed 2016-2017 budget and highlighted key changes vs. the current budget.

The following questions were asked about the budget:

Q: What is the remaining surplus?

A: Approximately \$240,000

Q: Is there a mechanism to increase the dollars in the budget if needed?

A: All school funding requests go through Assistant Principal Phoebe Cooper, and the PA can vote on any supplemental requests during the year

The proposed budget was approved by vote with none opposed.

**SLT Report:** Co-President Elizabeth Newberry shared the Comprehensive Education Plan (CEP) goals and preliminary metrics that were adopted for the upcoming school year:
