Bronx Science Admissions Process Update

Eleanor Coufos reported that there is an ongoing lawsuit regarding the increased Discovery Program from 6% to 20%. This Discovery Program is currently limited to the most socioeconomically distressed middle schools. Due to the lawsuit, the proposed

change for the Discovery Program for Specialized High Schools is currently in the courts and depending on what the judge says, will impact if changes to Discovery happen and/or the timing. (To be clear, this lawsuit was brought by a group of parents unrelated to Bronx Science)

In addition, there is a new bill proposed to the new NYS Legislature to change the Hecht Calandra Act, which specifies the SHSAT test as the only admissions criteria. This must go through the committee process. One on one and small group meetings with the lawmakers are ongoing to propose partnership solutions to improve NYC education.
