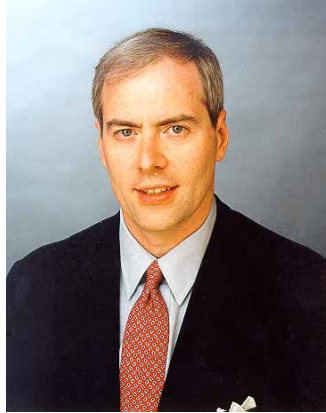


KALMAN A. CHANY



Kalman A. Chany is a nationally recognized expert on educational financing. He is the founder and president of Campus Consultants Inc., a Manhattan-based financial aid advisory firm. He is also the author of the annually-updated Princeton Review guidebook, *Paying for College* now in its 27th edition.

Kal has instructed prospective guidance counselors on financial aid as part of their Masters Decree program of study, and has conducted professional development programs on college funding for veteran high school guidance counselors and college advisors. His input has been sought and adopted by the U.S. Department of Education and the College Board regarding the development of various financial aid applications.

In addition to conducting hundreds of presentations on college financing issues for parents at schools, community groups and for corporate employee programs over the past three decades, Kal has presented at continuing education programs for the New York City Bar Association, the Financial Planning Association of New York, and for a number of CPA professional groups.

In addition to serving as the financial aid expert for an April 2013 segment on the nationally-broadcast ABC's World News Tonight with Diane Sawyer, Kal has also appeared on ABC's Good Morning America, the CBS Evening News, the NBC Nightly News, and has been interviewed on National Public Radio and many other radio and television programs. Kal has also been sourced on educational funding topics by reporters with the Associated Press, *Money*, the New York Times, USA TODAY, the Wall Street Journal, and many other media outlets.
