Parents' Association of The Bronx High School of Science PA Meeting June 13, 2023, 7:00pm In person and on Zoom

Christine Kattan commenced the meeting at 7:02

Michelle made a motion, seconded by Jamileh, to approve the 17 May 2023 meeting minutes, which were duly approved.

Christine Kattan began with thanks to Principal Rachel Hoyle for the year.

Principal's Report: Principal Hoyle reported that Rent was performed as the school musical; there were 2 spring concerts; the Research Expo was on 12 June; academic and sports teams are having celebrities; the carnival was held, as well as an Earth Day celebration and the spring Open House; Camp Science was canceled because of the wildfires, but will be part of orientation; there was a research celebration and senior awards. Seniors are unofficially done as of today. Their prom is on 6/2; the Alumni Foundation sponsors a BBQ for them on 6/21 when they collect their caps and gowns. There is school on 6/26 and 6/27 is the career symposium. Regents exams start tomorrow. Summer school and summer institutes are starting soon. Senior parents will be missed.

SLT Report: Yanjun Wang briefly discussed the CEP goals from the year and continued SEL. The SLT is exploring the implications of the new law reducing class sizes to 25 (other than for arts classes). The SLT is also doing community outreach to non-English-speaking school communities. There are active WhatsApp chats and translation for the Chinese community, but we need these networks and services for others. Elizabeth Polkovitz stressed that the DOE hasn't yet figured out what the smaller class size law will mean and, in any case, it will not be in effect for the '23-'24 school year.

Treasurer's Report: In the absence of Kai Lu, Elizabeth Polkovitz reported that we exceeded our fundraising goals and have actual revenues of \$502,109! The '23-'24 budget will be larger. The annual appeal brought in \$300,000. The gala: \$110,000 (with \$30,000 from the paddle raise). Raffles brought in about \$15.000. We have 3 a year and need to stay under a \$20,000 legal limit in order not to have to deal with other paperwork. We are planning a live comedy night for the fall and increasing financial support in several areas. Paul Sinclair made a motion to approve the budget; Bryan Liff seconded. The budget passed.
