Parents' Association of The Bronx High School of Science General Meeting 20 September 2023, 7:00 p.m. HYBRID

Co-President Christine Kattan called the meeting to order at 7:01.

Jamila motioned to approve the 13 June 23 PA meeting minutes; Jodi seconded; the minutes were approved.

New Business:

- 1) Introductions of PA Executive Board: Those in person introduced themselves; Jennifer Allen-Cheng introduced members attending remotely or absent. Members for the 2023-2024 school year are: Co-Presidents Jennifer Allen-Cheng, Christine Kattan and Elizabeth Polkovitz; Co-Vice Presidents Ernie Sander and Yan Yu; Treasurer Kai Lu; Assistant Co-Treasurers Ram Halder and Amy Xue; Co-Recording Secretaries Jennifer Courtian, Katia Kubicek and Wendy Stryker; Corresponding Secretary Xia (Lisa) Li; Members-At-Large: Nicole Allen, Maggie Gao, Dorie Paparo, Helen Qiu and Paul Sinclair.
- 2) Principal's Report: Rachel Hoyle spoke about:
 - In-person summer school and summer institutes, including in the Manne Center were a big success
 - There will be research in Manne also this fall
 - The new parent orientation was last week
 - The first Coffee with the Principal will focus on safety
 - 9th graders are all being programmed to go to SGI for a few weeks in an effort to remove any stigma there might be about attending
 - Afterschool activities are starting this coming week; the club fair was yesterday
 - There will be 3 Zoom panels of teachers and alumni who went to lesser-attended colleges of engineering, arts and sciences and women's colleges
 - Project Accepted is this weekend. Seniors have mock interviews and sessions with college reps. This helps the students promote themselves in their college applications
 - School is off to a great start, with a hiccup in the transitions from the BxSci Google domain to the DOE one, but this will be done eventually
 - Bronx Science has 43 National Merit semifinalists.
- 3) Parent Coordinator Rebecca Barreras can be contacted by phone and email (she checks both her BxSci and DOE email). Please reach out.

- 4) Treasurer's Report: Co-President Elizabeth Polkovitz reports for Kai that our finances are in good shape, especially with our band CDs earning interest over the summer.
- 5) Budget Vote: Elizabeth also reports that the direct appeal and gala income exceeded projections by almost \$50,000. The surplus is being distributed thusly:
 - We are trying to get live translations so language support services are increasing from \$1200 to \$3000
 - As per new rules, we were not allowed to mail donation letters to freshman families. These letters will be backpacked. Letters were also given out at orientation and will be again at tonight's general meeting. Mailing expenses are now \$4,300 (up from \$3,700)
 - PA electronic subscriptions will also go up to \$11,000 (up from \$8,100)-- this also includes Constant Contact
 - There is an adjustment to \$2800 for tax returns, supplies and miscellaneous
 - The club activities budget is up to \$15,000 from \$12,000
 - Club advisors expenses are being reduced to \$12,812 from \$20,000
 - \$750 is added for Regeneron/Research expenses.

We have a \$528,552 total budget for the year.

Jamila motion to approve amended budget; Nicole seconded. The revised budget was approved.

- 6) Fundraising: Elizabeth gave the report for the absent Yan Yu. Our direct appeal goal remains \$300,000. The suggested donation of \$750 per student, but any amount that is meaningful to you is meaningful to us. Every penny finds its way to better our school and support our students! 80% goes to students; the rest to technology support. Last year donations helped with: a) online resources and software; b) Naviance, c) Guidance/College Office expenses, d) student clubs, e) sports & academic teams, f) theater & arts programs; g) technology upgrades, h) student award dinners; i) graduation expensesThere are multiple ways to donate: 1) by phone, you can text 917-920-2677; 2) go to our PA website at bxsciencepa.org; 3) by regular mail (check for your fundraising letter). Don't forget to check if your employer will match your gift. We have 11 donations totaling \$7,938 so far. There is an optional donor wall recognition.
